VALE TO THE GREAT DR GEOFFREY RONALD WILSON – OAM MASTER LANDSCAPE PAINTER

Died 1 December 2024 – aged 97

Geoff Wilson - an Australian Art Treasure

Geoff Wilson deserves recognition for his extraordinary contribution to the arts over many years. As a master landscape painter, he created art for over 80 years, beginning in early teens, to when he died aged 97, for the last years painting some of the most accomplished works. When he died, he had a painting on the easel and a drawing in progress for another painting.

Geoff Wilson is a master landscape painter who enjoyed working directly in the landscape, often on expeditions in a group with other artistic friends and notable figures. His art was inspired by the land and spanned the rural, semi-rural and suburban; subjects include working farms where machinery, sheds and implements often take centre stage, some with rusty surfaces; he shows beauty in that rust.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Geoff Wilson was awarded the Order of Australia at the Queen's Birthday Celebration in June 2022 for his significant contribution to the arts.

In September 2022 Geoff Wilson was awarded a Doctorate from the University of South Australia, for his significant commitment to the arts as a practicing artist and to students of art, as Lecturer at the South Australian School of Art.

Geoff Wilson (above) gave a "Meet the Artist" talk; a riveting account from his early art student days, his intersection with artists such as Jeffrey Smart, his sketching and painting expeditions across Australia, Europe and the UK where he remembered levels of detail eg a Rembrandt exhibition in Venice in 1950s. An enquiring mind with an incredible memory!


